APPLICATION SUBMISSION CHECKLIST:

(Please arrange your packet in this order)

1. Complete all **four pages** of the application form. **Due to the Covid-19 crisis, some students may not have taken ACT/SAT tests. If applicable indicate this in the space for the test score.**
2. Write a personal letter including the following:
 - a. Your goals and objectives for the future;
 - b. Why you require financial assistance; and,
 - c. Why you feel you should be selected.
3. A grade transcript covering your entire high school career, including GPA and class rank.
4. A letter of acceptance from the university, college, or other institution of higher learning listed on the application.
5. A copy of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Student Aid Report(SAR).
6. Four (4) Letters of Recommendation should accompany the application. Letters should be from personal acquaintances, employers, clergy or teachers. It is best not to have all the letters from teachers. They should be from people who have known your family over a period of time. Letters need not be in separate envelopes.
7. You must arrange for a personal interview with members of the Masonic Lodge assigned to your high school. To schedule an interview, use the 'contact form' found at the bottom of our web-page. You should request your interview with the Lodge as soon as possible, as interview dates may be preselected by the Lodge. Your application and all required documents must be available for review at your interview. The Lodge will send an interview letter to the selection committee separately. Because of the current Covid-19 restrictions, lodges may, at their discretion, use an on-line platform such as Zoom, or a conference call or other media rather than a face-to-face interview.

Following the interview, the complete application form with all accompanying materials must be submitted together, in order, no later than **March 15** to be considered. The complete packet should be mailed to:
